Kazees of Gondal and Jatial are closely related and belong to famous KHATTAR clan who came with Muhammad Tughlaq from Khurraan. They adopted the title of Kazi or Qazi after their ancestor Qazi Ali Qadar who was an appointee of king of Hindostan (Dheli).
