There are three strong Biradaries in Attock District. These are the Khatars, the Awana, and the Sheikhs. Among these, the Khatar Biradari is strong and it has about 20,000 to 25,000 votes in NA 57. The second strongest Biradari of the district is the Sheiks, whose strength is about 18,000 to 20,000, and the third Awan Biradari has about 10,000 to 13,000 votes. Since 1990, the NA-57 seat has been won by the PML (N)'s Sheik Aftab Ahmed who is a friend of Nawaz Sharif. In 1988, however, this seat was won by Malik Muhammad Aslam Khan.
