PML(N) candidate Malik Suhail is the son of Malik Lal Khan of Kamrial who was previously in NPP with Jatoti and then joined PML(N) winning this seat in 1997.

Malik Suhail should get appreciably more votes this time as compared to 2002. But the district nazim Maj. Tahir Sadiq has strong influence in the area and is actively campaigning for Parvez Ilahi. Unless Malik Allah Yar strongly comes out in opposition of Parvez Ilahi, he seems to enjoy the leading position.
