I am not happy to give too much personal info like this but I can confirm that my father had four other children from our useless irish step-mother (I'll tell you all about that sometime!) and they are called Umber Sadique (Now called Patrick, he a Jehovas Witness and lives in Holland, then theres Sadiqia (don't where she is) then John and finally Lisa (lives in Stourbridge). It is a very long story, but interesting enough I suppose.

As your parents may already know, my dad died in 1997 and before he died he asked all his children. individually if we wanted to inherit his land in Pakistan afetr his death. Me Aly and Hassan Zetoon, Fatima, Khadeja and Ameina all said that we would prefer if he left it all to his direct relations in Adalzai. Finally, John did agree to accept the land.
